

1	<b>Lummi Transit Operations</b>	Maintain existing fixed route service on the Lummi Reservation and to the city of Ferndale
2	<b>Lummi Bus Shelters (Cap)</b>	Purchase and install bus shelters at high volume transit stops to protect passengers during inclement weather.
3	<b>Lummi Transit Facility (Cap)</b>	Construct a transit facility for buses, storage, and administrative office and meeting space to support existing transit service.
4	<b>Passes and Tokens</b>	Purchase and provide transit passes and ride coupons to social service agencies for distribution to people with special
5	<b>East County Shuttle</b>	Operate scheduled service connecting small cities in eastern Whatcom County with each other & WTA
6	<b>Multi-Lingual Improvements</b>	Develop an action plan for providing transit information in multiple languages and creating a multi-cultural outreach program. Increase multi-cultural awareness among transportation professionals. Staff and fund implementation.
7	<b>Travel Training</b>	Conduct education and marketing outreach and education to inform special needs populations about transportation options and bus riding. Develop new outreach methods and support existing travel training.
8	<b>Volunteer Driver Support</b>	Reimburse costs incurred by volunteer drivers providing rides for people with special needs using private vehicles
9	<b>Mobile Food Bank</b>	Coordinate food delivery service for seniors and people with special needs. Collaborate with Meals on Wheels and with other Food Banks in County.
10	<b>Mobility Management</b>	Expand community outreach to educate seniors, special needs travelers and their families and the general public on transportation options, and assist them to use the systems.
11	<b>Children's Bicycle Project</b>	Fund operations of educational program teaching low-income children and adults about bicycle transportation and repair, assist them to acquire and maintain bicycles for daily use.
12	<b>Bicycle Share (Op)</b>	Maintain and operate fleet, equipment, and software for community-side shared bicycle fleet and docking stations.
13	<b>Emergency Management</b>	Work with Emergency Management departments, fire districts, and enforcement staff to plan for special needs transportation during emergencies.
14	<b>Medical Shuttle (Cap)</b>	Purchase wheel-chair accessible van for providing medical shuttle service to specialists and VA hospitals outside Whatcom County. Partner with VFW and others.
15	<b>Trip Planner Website (Op)</b>	Develop and operate internet-based trip planner software system with multiple transportation service providers; develop protocol for automatic update of schedule and rate data.
16	<b>Evening/Sunday Service</b>	Expand operations to provide fixed route service on more routes during evenings, weekends, and major holidays by public or private transit providers.

17	<b>Mental Health Awareness</b>	Conduct trainings for WTA staff and other transportation professionals to improve skills interacting with people with mental health conditions. Staff and implement outreach programs.
18	<b>Medical Shuttle (Op)</b>	Provide services for medical shuttle service to out-of-county services for special needs residents.
19	<b>Neighborhood Outreach</b>	Provide guidance and assistance to neighborhood groups (including school-based groups) to conduct outreach activities (including safe walk route events) to increase child transportation safety, reduce senior isolation and prepare for emergency situations.
20	<b>School Walk Routes (Cap)</b>	Construct sidewalks or multi-use path along streets near elementary schools.
21	<b>Shared Vehicles (Op)</b>	Plan and coordinate a system to increase the cost-sharing among groups, places of worship, and others for vans and mini-buses.
22	<b>Shared Vehicles (Cap)</b>	Purchase vehicles to supplement the existing vehicles shared by non-profit and human service organizations collaborating on transport of people with special needs.
23	<b>Bicycle Share (Cap)</b>	Purchase equipment for community-wide shared bicycle fleet and docking stations to supplement public transit.
24	<b>Bike Parking (Op)</b>	Manage and operate bike parking and bike lockers at shelters, libraries, transit hubs and other locations for use by people with special needs.
25	<b>Regional Trip Brokerage (Op)</b>	Plan, coordinate, and manage a regional integrated travel brokerage service based on the FTA pilot project MART Integrated Traveler Services (2008).
26	<b>Car Share Program (Op)</b>	Coordinate, Market and manage a community car-sharing project to provide low income residents with occasional access to vehicles at low cost.
27	<b>Wheelchair Taxi Fund</b>	Establish and manage a fund to reimburse low-income wheelchair users the amount of the access fee charged by private taxi services.
28	<b>Bike Parking (Cap)</b>	Purchase and install bike lockers at shelters, libraries, transit hubs, low-income housing, schools, employment centers, etc. for use by people with special needs.
29	<b>Car Share Program (Cap)</b>	Purchase vehicles, equipment, software, etc. for car sharing program.
30	<b>Regional Trip Brokerage (Cap)</b>	Purchase equipment and software to manage the brokerage service.
31	<b>East County Shuttle (Cap)</b>	Purchase equipment to provide scheduled shuttle service connecting small cities and villages in eastern Whatcom County with each other.
32	<b>RideShare On-line</b>	Plan and coordinate a mobile-device-based regional ride share system pilot project.
33	<b>Intercounty Connector (Op)</b>	Operate job access shuttle service between Whatcom, Skagit, and Island Counties with link to San Juan Ferry.

34	<b>Forest Service Shuttle (Op)</b>	Provide administrative, operations, publicity and maintenance services for shuttle transport between Mt. Baker Recreation Area and transit station.
35	<b>EACH Plan Update</b>	Coordinate, collaborate with partners, research, conduct outreach, and publish update for EACH plan. Coordinate planning for sharing vehicles to maximize resource use and cost efficiencies.
36	<b>WTA Paratransit Mini-buses (Cap)</b>	Purchase vehicles to replace 11 aging specialized transportation minibuses.
37	<b>Intercounty Connector (Cap)</b>	Purchase vehicles to provide job access shuttle service between Whatcom, Skagit, and/or Island Counties, and/or Anacortes Ferry.
38	<b>Video Monitoring (Cap)</b>	purchase and install video recording equipment to upgrade security technology on all fixed route vehicles.
39	<b>Forest Service Shuttle (Cap)</b>	Purchase shuttle bus vehicle to transport workers and customers between Mt. Baker Recreation Area and transit station.
40	<b>WTA Bus Shelters (Cap)</b>	Purchase and install new bus shelters to replace 70 deteriorated structures.
41	<b>Fare Box Upgrade (Op)</b>	Maintain and operate fare collection software and equipment to enable single-day multi-ride passes and other fare structure changes.
42	<b>Fare Box Upgrade (Cap)</b>	Purchase equipment and software to implement fare structure changes including single-day multi-ride passes.
43	<b>Real-Time Bus Signage (Cap)</b>	Purchase and install equipment and software to indicate next bus arrival time at bus shelters/hubs.
44	<b>Real-Time Bus Signage (Op)</b>	Manage and maintain equipment and software
45	<b>Lummi Island Transit (Cap)</b>	Purchase equipment for pilot project for island-based transit shuttle using innovative, energy efficient technology.
46	<b>Automatic Vehicle Locator (AVL) Technology (Cap)</b>	Purchase, install, and operate devices that track location of WTA fixed route buses and relay real-time info to special needs travelers.
47	<b>WTA Vanpool Vans (Cap)</b>	Purchase new vanpool vans to replace six aging vehicles
