Increase transit access in areas with new housing developments, especially multi-family and low-income units



Maintain service on existing corridors and to key destinations as much as practical



Increase operational efficiency by realigning underperforming routes

The number of bus trips is increasing




The number of bus trips is decreasing












Unfortunately, because several of our new buses can't complete the U-turn at Birch Bay Village, we'll be eliminating up to eight trips to the area shaded in yellow.

Removes service on Levine Lane and through Cornwall Park Neighborhood




Both areas have low ridership and are within about a five-minute walk to the nearest bus stop

While some people may need to walk a little further, everyone will have twice as much bus service compared to today




East Bakerview Rd between Meridian St and James St

OPERATIONS AND REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION CONNECTIONS


Bellingham International Airport (BLI) is a vital transportation hub in the Pacific Northwest:

- Provides essential air services to northwest Washington and southern British Columbia residents and offers a range of domestic flights.
- Due to its convenience and ease of access, it has become a popular alternative to larger airports like Seattle-Tacoma International Airport (SEA) and Vancouver International Airport (YVR).
- BLI is well-connected to regional transportation networks, including Interstate 5, facilitating seamless travel to nearby cities such as Seattle and Vancouver.
- BLI offers various public transportation options, such as the Whatcom Transportation Authority (WTA), which links the airport to downtown Bellingham and surrounding areas.
- Quick Coach, Bellair Shuttle and TRAXX bus services.
- Other ground transportation & TNCs includes: Yellow Cab, Evergreen Town Car, NW Limo, Red Cab, Lyft

These connections make BLI an accessible and efficient choice for travelers looking to avoid the congestion of larger airports while still benefiting from robust regional transportation links.

Aaska Airines

- The frequency of flights from Bellingham to Seattle can vary depending on the airline schedules and the time of year.
- Typically, this route is served by regional airlines such as Alaska Airlines through its subsidiary, Horizon Air.
- There are usually multiple daily flights, providing convenient options for travelers. The short distance between the two cities—approximately 90 miles—makes it a popular route for both business and leisure travelers.
- Flight times are generally under an hour, making it a quick and efficient way to travel between Bellingham and Seattle.

Charter flights are available to the other islands and nearby airports






2023 vs 2024 Enplanements
