Subject: Request for Vacation Leave Increase

Next month, I'll have been on board as Executive Director for seven years. According to WCOG's Personnel Manual, the Executive Director becomes eligible for 25 days of annual vacation leave following the completion of his or her ninth year of service, meaning I'm two years away from reaching that milestone. That said, I hereby request the Executive Committee to waive those two years and allow me to begin accruing vacation leave at the 25-day per year rate beginning on my anniversary date of April 23rd.

Since my wife died last year, I've found that I've needed to use more personal leave to pick up the slack left in her absence, particularly as it relates to our kids' needs. However, in using my vacation time for that purpose, I'm concerned that I won't be able to take actual vacations as often as I'd like, and I feel that I need those opportunities to "recharge my batteries" more than ever.

For your information, since joining WCOG I have never requested a salary increase, nor have I received one beyond annual cost of living adjustments that all staff members receive.

SUGGESTED MOTION: Move to waive the nine-year service requirement in the WCOG Personnel Manual and allow the Executive Director, Bob Wilson, to begin accruing vacation leave at the rate of 25 days per year beginning immediately upon the completion of his seventh year of service, acknowledging that by this action the Executive Committee is not amending said section of the Personnel Manual.
